*There are no term limits.*

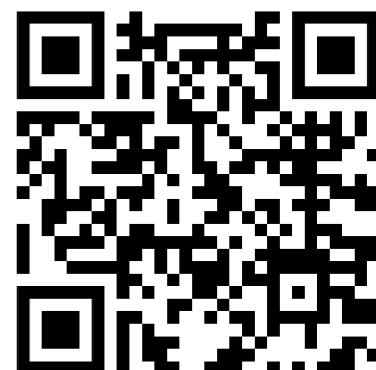
## AWARDS
