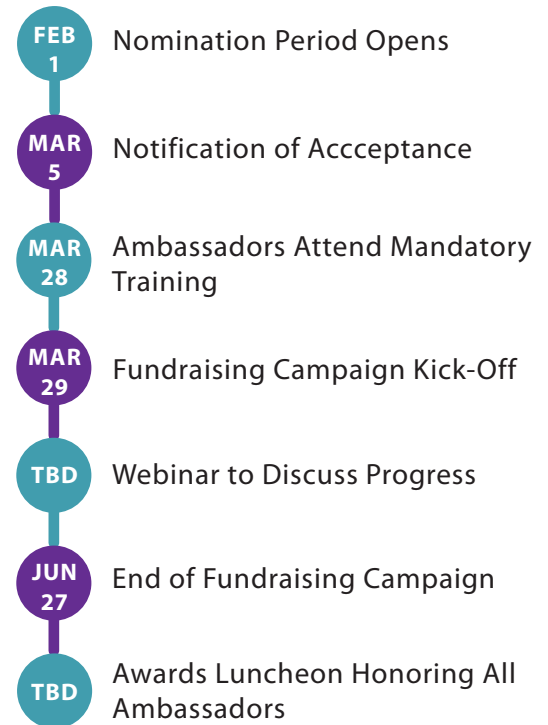




## 2021 Campaign Timeline
